




Brother Knights,

I hope all is well with you and your families. As we near the end of summer and begin the fall portion of our new fraternal year, several activities have been added to calendar. Of course, with the current environment, these events and activities will be somewhat scaled back to comply with the required guidelines. Granted the coronavirus is still upon us and we have learned a lot since the initial lockdown. As the state is opening in phases, we too can increase our level of activity using safe practices such as masks and gloves. The leadership team and I look forward to re-engaging the council after nearly six months of quarantine.

For example, we will be holding the MI Drive this fall during the Columbus Day weekend at Holiday Market and after each mass at St. Thomas a'Becket. We will also be working with the Parish Coat Drive team to support their effort with people to sort and bag coats and other winter wear. In our meeting with Father last fall, we were able to pull the coat drive forward so the coats could be collected and distributed in time for winter. Our annual food drive begins in September. Details will be sent out soon.

With the scaled back activities, we are also operating with limited income. At this point in time, without charity poker and pancake breakfasts, our income is basically limited to our dues. So, this year, the leadership team drafted a budget, I presented it at our general business meeting and

the council members approved it. We are still able to continue our support of many of the charities, the parish and other events/activities/groups, just at a reduced amount.

We will continue to use the hybrid meeting options to include as many members as possible. This format addresses many levels of comfort while providing everyone the ability to participate. The number of members in person and online nearly doubled this month from 15 to 28. We will continue to meet at the Renaud Council building space so that we can conduct our in-person meetings and business until space is available at St. Thomas a'Becket.

The council is off to a great start with growing our membership. We have increased the number of e-Members from one to four during this month. One e-Member completed the Exemplification this month and is now a full Knight with our council.

Remember, most of the time, just asking someone to join brings in a new member.


